

Safe Spaces Policy:

Your SU is committed to ensuring that every member feels welcome here, and enabled to participate in empowering, non-judgemental and non-threatening discussions, activities, services and events. Members should be free from intimidation, harassment, and the deliberate, or negligent creation of unsafe or unwelcoming conditions.

We have zero tolerance of:

1. Sexual comments (including comments about your body or private life).
2. Unwelcome sexual invitations, innuendoes, and offensive gestures.
3. Wolf whistling, catcalling or offensive sexual noises.
4. Groping, pinching or smacking of your body, such as your bottom or breasts.
5. Having your clothes or top lifted without agreeing.
6. Someone exposing their sexual organs to you without consent.
7. Any unwanted comments which makes someone uncomfortable are unacceptable.

Your SU believes that all students should be free from intimidation or harassment, resulting from prejudice or discrimination on the grounds of (the list is not exhaustive):-

- Age
- Disability
- Sexual Orientation
- Marital status
- Maternity/Paternity Status
- Race
- Religious Beliefs
- Ideology or beliefs
- Culture
- Any other form of distinction

Consequence:

Any breach of this policy will result in immediate ejection from the site, pending further investigation to be carried out by the Students' Union University of Greenwich.
