- Attend and represent students at the follow meetings

 - o Faculty Health and Safety Committee
 - Annual Members Meeting
- Gather and present issues to staff and programme reps at the termly Faculty Forum meetings
- Support Programme Representatives from your faculty in their roles and campaigns
- Engage Programme Representatives and other students from your faculty to gather information and feedback
- Engagement with students can be completed using a variety of methods including holding focus groups, drop-in sessions, surveys, and social media engagement tools.
- You should aim to run a campaign, lobby drive or initiative around your manifesto points and GSU priorities selected by students. This can be done as an entire Faculty Officer team
- You can do a joint campaign with other Faculty Officers (outside your faculty) or contributing specific outcomes to a GSU Officer priority campaign.
